An 18-Month Guide for What to Study Next



SPEAKER: MULTIPLE SPEAKERS



This is a great discussion generator for people at all points of spiritual maturity. Distinguishing between what Jesus asked of his followers and what organized religion imposes on its followers, this study is an easy entry point for people who are open to Jesus but don't like the norms of Christianity.
