CONNECT

Have you ever asked your friends what other people say about you? If so, what did you learn? If not, what do you hope your friends say about you?

LEARN

You will watch a shortened version of a message from this series to set up your group discussion. Encourage your group members to watch the full message sometime this week to remind them of what you talked about.

APPLY

After giving your group members an opportunity to share what stood out from the video, discuss the following questions as a group:

1.	On a scale of 1 to 10, where do you find yourself in terms of being engaged with a local	
	church? What makes you say that?

- 2. Have you thought (before today) about the reality that you are a steward of faith in this generation? Look at how you answered question 1. What does that say about how effectively you are stewarding this responsibility?
- 3. Our mission is to inspire people to follow Jesus by engaging people with the life and mission of their local church. Here are three ways you can participate in that mission:
 - Look for "Come sit with me" opportunities. Listen for the three "nots" and be ready to invite someone (not in church, not going well, not prepared for life circumstances).
 - » When was the last time you asked someone to come sit with you? What happened?
 - » Do you have any hesitation in asking someone to come sit with you? If so, what is it?





· Participate in a small group.

- » Pat yourself on the back; you can check this one off!
- » If you have been in a group for a little while, is it time to consider leading one? Why or why not?

Volunteer.

- » If you are currently volunteering, talk about your experience doing so.
- » If you don't currently volunteer, do you know what volunteer opportunities exist in your local church? What is an area where you could serve?

WRAP UP

Our Atlanta-area churches don't measure membership in the typical sense, but instead measure a person's engagement in four areas:

- 1. Participate in a Group | Connect
- 2. Serve on a Team | Serve
- 3. Support the Church Financially | Give
- 4. Invite Friends to Church | Invite

Are you fully engaged? If not, what's stopping you?

PRAY

Take some time to pray as a group. Thank God that you have the opportunity to be a part of the movement he started, and ask for wisdom on how to steward it well. Andy's prayer from this message could be a good starting place.
