LEARN

APPLY

After sharing what stood out from the video, discuss the following questions as a group:

- 1. Can you relate to believing that you need to do certain things to be accepted into heaven? Where did that belief come from?
- 2. Read **Romans 3:23**. How does this verse challenge the notion that we can be good enough to go to heaven?
- 3. Andy says in the video, "He didn't give us a to-do list. He gave us a who and invited all of us to place our trust in him." Why do you think we tend to try and earn favor with God even though it has already been given to us through Jesus?

BEFORE NEXT TIME

There's no set formula on how to get to heaven. But there is a relationship. There isn't a way through deeds, behaviors, or being good enough. Instead, there is the one who said he is the way.

Spend some time this week reflecting on **John 14:6**, "Jesus answered, 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."





PRAY

Pray together and thank God for how he provided a way for us to have a restored relationship with him. Spend a few moments in silence as a group, allowing the Holy Spirit to remind you that you are loved and pursued by the Father.
