Description

After Jesus explained his final promise and plan and then ascended to heaven, his followers were asked a question. It's a question we should be asking ourselves because the answer could change our lives.

Questions

- 1. Can you relate to being so overwhelmed by a project, problem, or mess that you felt paralyzed? Share the story.
- 2. What is something you've accomplished that seemed impossible when you first considered it?
- 3. How often or in what ways do you interact with people from different cultures or places? Are these interactions intentional or situational?
- 4. Take a minute to reflect on the following graphic. How does the local church equip you to be a witness in the following areas? How can you be a witness in each of these areas?
- "In Jerusalem" (i.e., with your family, friends, and neighbors)
- "In Judea and Samaria" (i.e., with people who aren't like you)

• "To the ends of the earth" (i.e., far outside your comfort zone)
