Why Do You Stand Here?

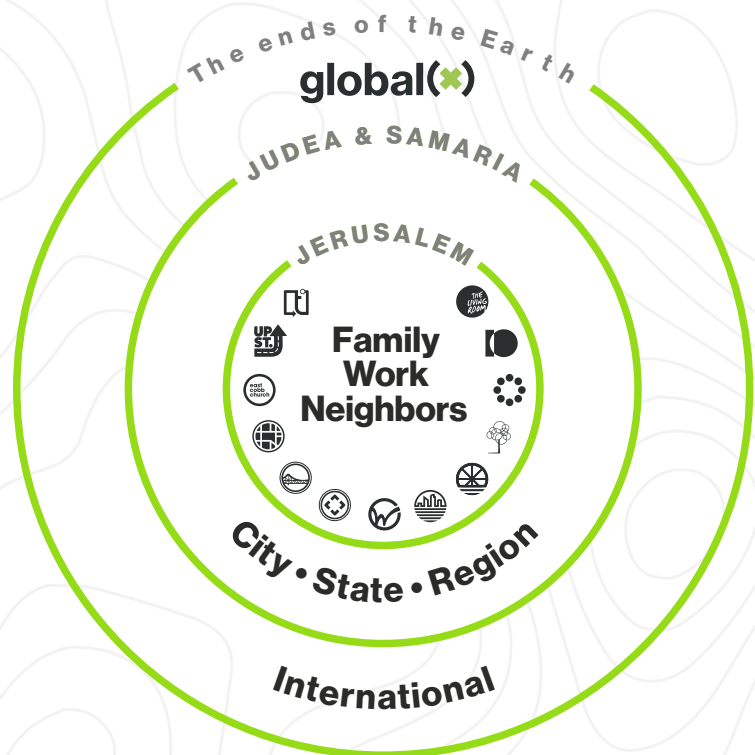
Description

After Jesus explained his final promise and plan and then ascended to heaven, his followers were asked a question. It's a question we should be asking ourselves because the answer could change our lives.

Questions

1. Can you relate to being so overwhelmed by a project, problem, or mess that you felt paralyzed? Share the story.
2. What is something you've accomplished that seemed impossible when you first considered it?
3. How often or in what ways do you interact with people from different cultures or places? Are these interactions intentional or situational?
4. Take a minute to reflect on the following graphic. How does the local church equip you to be a witness in the following areas? How can you be a witness in each of these areas?

- “In Jerusalem” (i.e., with your family, friends, and neighbors)
- “In Judea and Samaria” (i.e., with people who aren't like you)
- “To the ends of the earth” (i.e., far outside your comfort zone)



5. Consider the question Jesus's followers were asked: Why do you stand here?

What obstacles or hesitations come to mind when you think about being a witness
“to the ends of the earth”?
